

## **NYSE Listing Requirements:**

1. **Public Shareholders and Public Float:** Companies must have at least 1.1 million publicly held shares and meet one of the following criteria:
  - At least 400 shareholders holding 100 shares or more.
  
2. **Financial Requirements:** Companies must meet one of the following financial criteria:
  - **Market Value of Publicly Held Shares:** At least \$40 million.
  - **Market Value of Total Shares:** At least \$75 million.
  
3. **Corporate Governance:** Companies must comply with corporate governance standards, including having a majority of independent directors on the board and establishing audit, compensation, and nominating committees.

## **Committee Exemptions:**

1. **Smaller Reporting Companies:** These companies may qualify for certain exemptions from the compensation committee requirements. For example, they may not need to have a fully independent compensation committee if they meet the SEC's definition of a smaller reporting company.
